An expert in police, justice and security sector reform, Georges Kuzma has worked for twenty years in France, and for the last thirteen years in a number of countries including Chad, Mauritania, Kenya, Iraq, Pakistan, Ukraine, the Central African Republic and the Democratic Republic of Congo.

He gained his professional experience with the French police, most notably as a forensic investigator specializing in terrorism and serious crime with the Direction Centrale de la Police Judiciaire, then his international experience as project manager for a European police mission, working on the creation of national forensic networks.

He then left the administration and turned his activities to the documentation of international crimes and war crimes, with a focus on conflict-related sexual violence and torture. In addition to his training and consultancy activities, he has worked on complex investigations linked to the conflicts of recent years.
