

1. CALL FOR TENDERS

Consultancy services to produce a briefing paper on the law and practice of universal jurisdiction in Argentina

TRIAL International, implementing the project "Global Initiative Against Impunity for International Crimes and Serious Human Rights Violations: Making Justice Work" under EU funding, is procuring services to promote accountability under extraterritorial and universal jurisdiction.

Participation in tendering is open on equal terms to natural and legal persons. No more than one tender can be submitted by a natural or legal person. In the event that a natural or legal person submits more than one tender, all tenders in which that person has participated will be excluded. Subcontracting is allowed, however any subcontracting needs to be already included and identified in the offer and will be subject to the same rules as the contractor.

The following criteria will be applied to the tenderers:

Part A: Selection

Professional and technical capacity of the tenderer:

- 1- Professional certificate appropriate to this contract, such as a master's degree in domestic or international law, with specific focus on criminal law;
- 2- Extensive knowledge of the legal framework and practice of extraterritorial and universal jurisdiction in Argentina;
- 3- At least 6 years of relevant legal and/or research experience, of which at least 3 in the international criminal law sector;
- 4- Experience in researching substantive and procedural aspects of international and domestic criminal law;
- 5- Experience in litigating or supporting litigation of international crimes under extraterritorial and universal jurisdiction;
- 6- Experience in report writing with prior publication experience;
- 7- Fluency in Spanish and English mandatory.

The quality of each technical offer will be evaluated in accordance with the selection criteria and the weighting further detailed in the evaluation grid of the tender dossier.

Part B: Award

Upon completion of the technical evaluation, the envelopes containing the financial offers for tenders that were not eliminated during the technical evaluation will be opened.

The award criteria is the best price-quality ratio, established by weighing technical quality against price on an 80/20 basis.

The submission of offer to this call for tender may not result in the award of a contract.

TRIAL International will not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by the tenderers in connection with the preparation and submission of their tenders to TRIAL International.



2. TERMS OF REFERENCE

2.1 CONTEXT

The project "Global Initiative Against Impunity for International Crimes and Serious Human Rights Violations: Making Justice Work" financed by the European Union seeks to address an increasing climate of impunity for core international crimes and serious human rights violations through fostering comprehensive justice and accountability.

The services to be provided under this contract will support TRIAL International's efforts in fighting impunity for international crimes through extraterritorial and universal jurisdiction. In order to contribute to a better understanding of national justice systems and to support strategic decision-making related to the case-building and litigation of cases based on extraterritorial and universal jurisdiction, TRIAL International seeks to conduct research on the current legal framework and practice related to extraterritorial and universal jurisdiction in Argentina. This consultancy aims at producing and publishing a briefing paper that will provide legal practitioners and civil society actors with in-depth analysis and practical guidance on the law and practice of extraterritorial and universal jurisdiction cases in Argentina. This paper will be part of the <u>Universal Jurisdiction Law and Practice Briefing Papers series</u>.

2.2 OBJECTIVE, PURPOSE & EXPECTED RESULTS

The purposes of this contract are to:

- 1) Collect information, through desk research and interviews, on the legal framework and practice of extraterritorial and universal jurisdiction in Argentina;
- 2) Analyze and compile the information collected;
- 3) Draft a report on "Universal Jurisdiction Law and Practice in Argentina".

Results to be achieved by the consultant are:

- 1) A work schedule, research questions, methodology and tools, such questionnaires, are drafted;
- 2) A list of relevant practitioners/experts and organizations/institutions is drafted;
- Contact with relevant actors, who could contribute to the research through interviews or partnerships, is established and maintained for the conduct of research, and consent forms and/or MoUs are drafted in order to conduct interviews and establish partnerships;
- 4) Desk research and interviews are conducted;
- 5) The sources of the research are compiled in a precise and secure digital form;
- 6) A draft briefing paper on "Universal Jurisdiction Law and Practice in Argentina", which respects a minimum of 15'000 and a maximum of 20'000 words, is written, in English, in a format agreed with TRIAL International;
- 7) A final draft is produced by integrating edits provided by TRIAL International;

3.3 CONTENTS OF TENDERS

The tender must comprise of a technical offer and a financial offer, which must be submitted in separate envelopes. The outer envelope must thus contain two separate, sealed envelopes, one bearing the words 'Envelope A — Technical offer' and the other 'Envelope B — Financial offer'. Each technical offer and financial offer must contain one original, clearly marked 'Original', and one copy, marked 'Copy'.

The outer envelope should provide the following information:

- a) the address for submitting tenders indicated above;
- b) the reference code of the tender procedure;
- c) the words 'Not to be opened before the tender-opening session';
- d) the name of the tenderer.

The pages of the technical and financial offers must be numbered.

All correspondence and documents related to the tender must be written in English. Supporting documents and printed literature furnished by the tenderer may be in another language. Prices have to be in euro (\in) and inclusive of all applied taxes.

Answers to this tender must include the following elements:

- 1) In 'Envelope A Technical offer':
